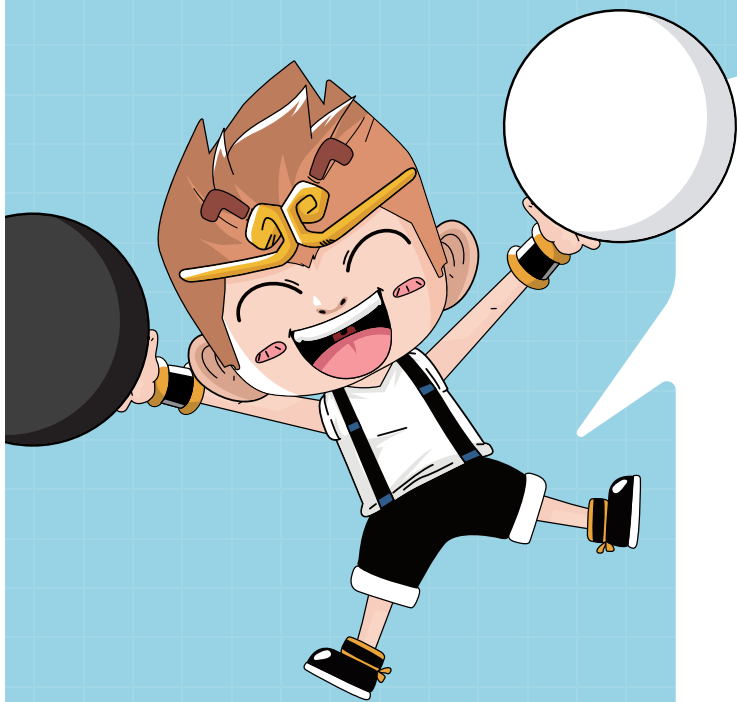

Capturing Stones Within the Territory

Even if stones form an enclosed shape, if only one liberty remains, you can block all liberties to capture them.

Saving Stones Within the Territory

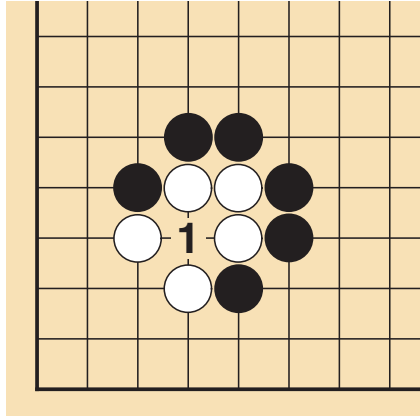
Even if stones form an enclosed shape, if they have only one liberty, you can place a stone to extend their liberties and save them.



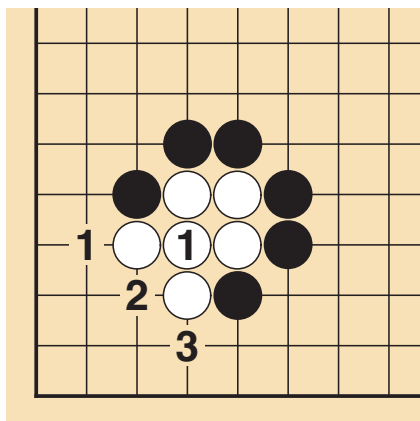

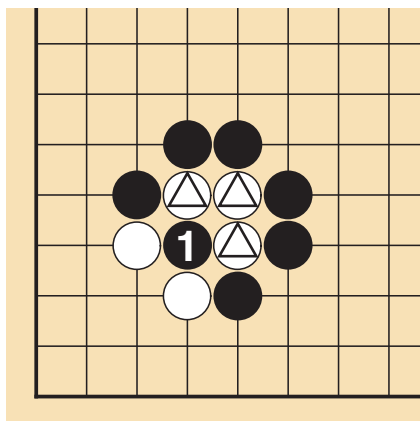
🐱 Capturing Stones Within the Territory



01 White stones have one liberty.

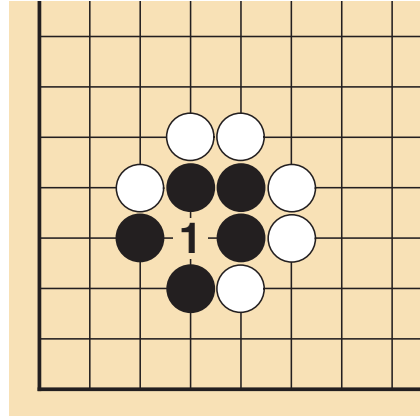


02 If a white player places a stone (White 1) first, then white stones gain more liberties.

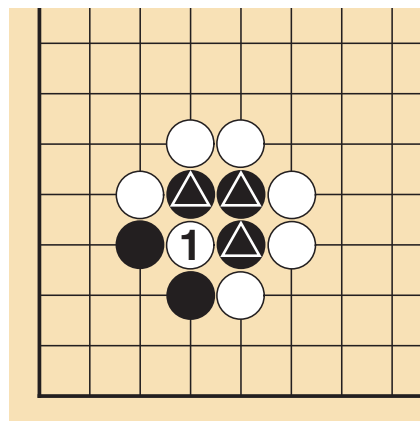


03 Conversely if a black player place a black stone (Black 1) first, then white stones are captured.

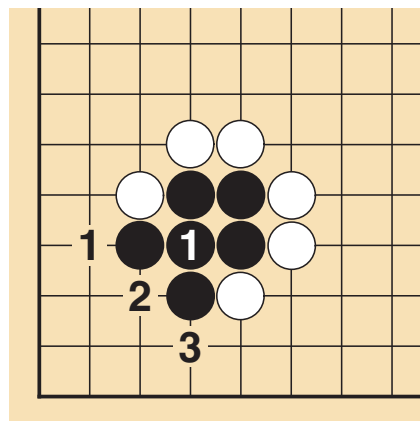
🐱 Saving Stones Within the Territory



01 Black stones have one liberty.



02 If white moves first and blocks the liberty of the black stones, it will be captured.



03 Place black stone (Black 1) to save the black stones.



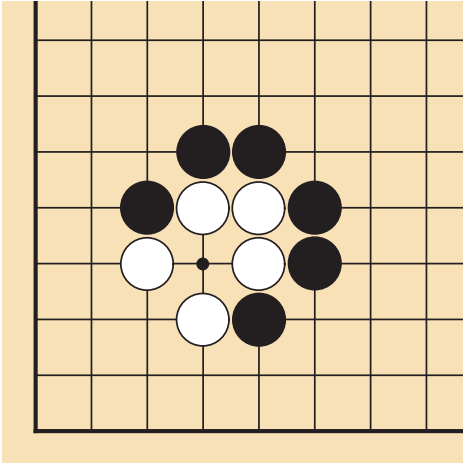
